Text: Revelation 9:1, 13-14 *1 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.*

13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, 14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

I. The Abyss and _____ vs. 1

A. An _____

Note: This “star from heaven” is an angel – “to him it was given...”

Revelation 20:1 *And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.*

Luke 10:18 *And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.*

Isaiah 14:12-15 *How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.*

Note: *bottomless* = depthless

Luke 8:31 *And they besought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep.*

2 Peter 2:4 *For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;*

C. _____

Note: *Apollyon* = “a destroyer”

John 8:44 *Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.*

John 10:10 *The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.*

II. An Army of _____ vs.13

Note: Again, this is not symbolizing something earthly. This is an army of evil spirits – led by these four powerful demons. (vs. 14)

Note: The army is released at a precise time, for a special purpose: to kill (not just torment) a third of the world’s population. (vs. 15)

Note: Since a fourth of mankind has already been killed (Rev. 6:8), this means that half of the world’s population will be dead by the time this sixth trumpet judgment is completed.

III. The Amalgamation of the _____ vs.20

A. _____

1 Corinthians 10:19-21 *What say I then? that the idol is any thing, or that which is offered in sacrifice to idols is any thing? 20 But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. 21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord’s table, and of the table of devils.*
